HIGHLIGHTS

- Provides appropriate graduate-level research experiences through supervised assignment of a funded research project.
- An 11-month position (must work during academic breaks).

- Research project may be incorporated into a thesis or dissertation as appropriate, with faculty approval.
- Tuition waiver (must meet criteria).
- Compensation starts at GA-R5 (\$15,552/year).
- Health insurance benefits (must work 20-hours per week).

REQUIREMENTS

- Must have been admitted by the University of Hawaii's Graduate School as a degree seeking student *BEFORE* being considered for a graduate assistantship.
- In good academic standing and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above.

- Possess necessary qualifications and experience for the assistantship. Baccalaureate degree in the following disciplines:
 - Chemical, Mechanical, Electrical and/or Bio Engineering
 - Materials Science
 - Natural Sciences (i.e., chemistry, physics)
 - Ocean related disciplines
- Demonstrate proficiency in English**

**TOEFL scores of 600/250/100 or above, with subtest scores of 25 for listening and 25 for speaking, or IELTS score of 7.0 or above for the overall band test results.
